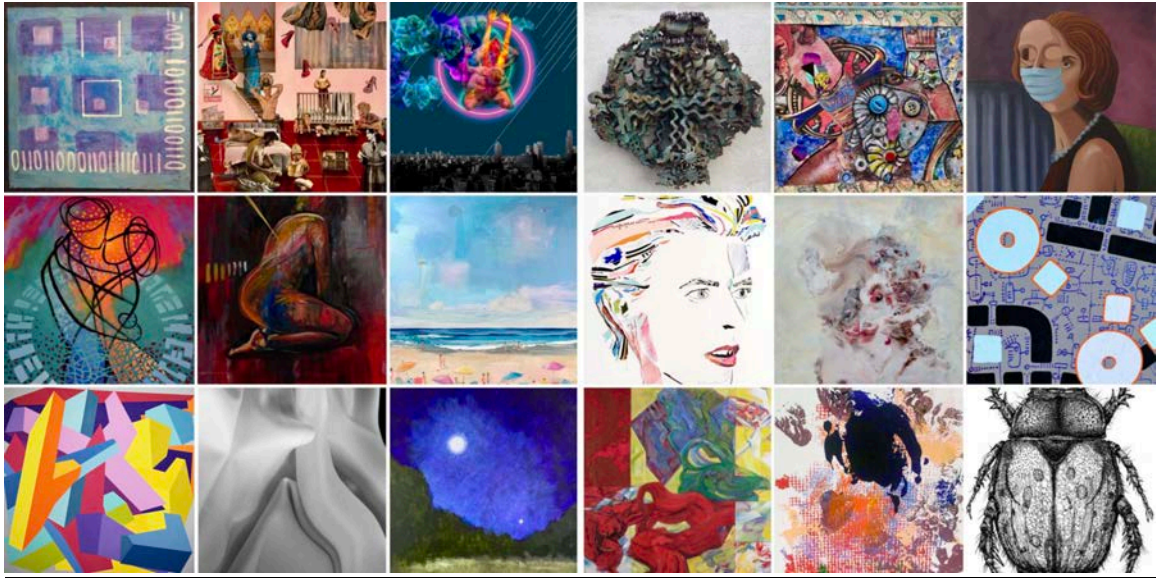

The 9th Annual West Chelsea Artists Open Studios reopening on Friday, May 20th, Saturday, May 21st, and Sunday, May 22nd, 12-6 p.m., in the heart of the West Chelsea gallery district.

Over Seventy artists will be on-hand to show their most recent artworks and discuss their artistic practice. Artworks will be available in a wide range of media including — but not limited to— painting, sculpture, photography, mixed-media, textiles, prints, collage, street art, and much more!

While typically only accessible by appointment, visitors will be granted access “behind the scenes” to explore each artist’s creative space. The intimate setting gives collectors the rare opportunity to purchase artworks directly from the artists’ inventory without the gallery markup. It’s also a fantastic way to discover new emerging talent while their work is still affordable.
